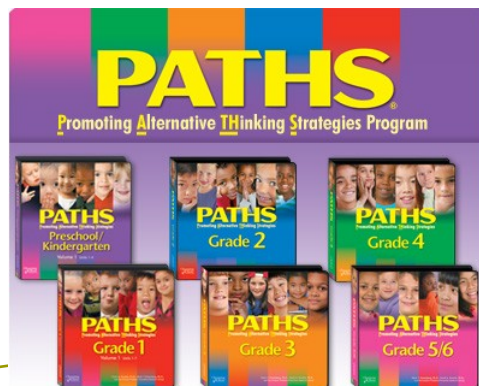

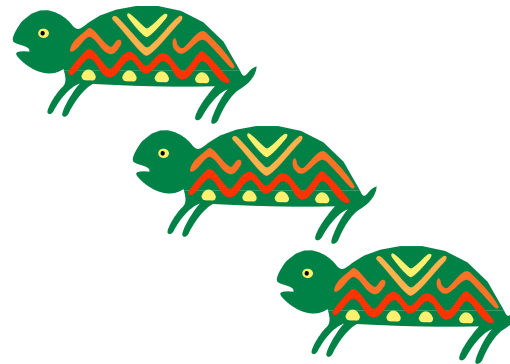


Call for Presenters

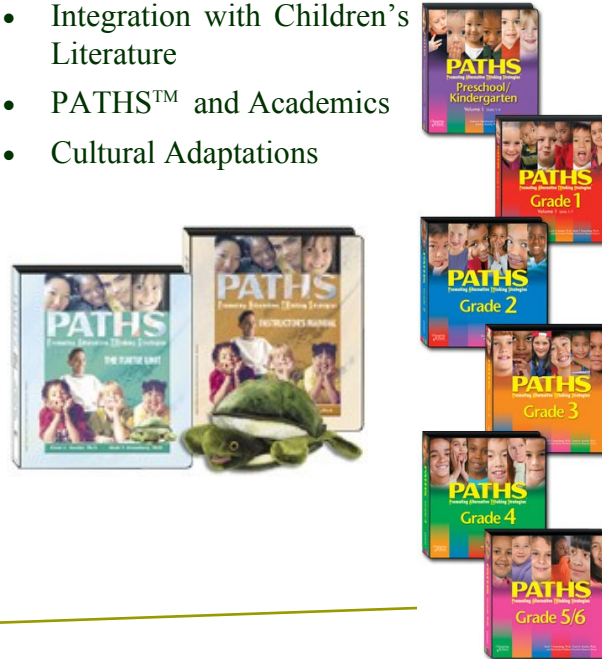
